Written comments will outline what the pupil has done well and a target of how to improve. ● Students will be given time and opportunities to respond to this feedback after key pieces of work. ● Assessments will take place throughout the course. Pupils will be informed on how to improve on future assessments. ● Booklets will be checked every half term. This is to check literacy, numeracy, key terms, effort and presentation of work. <p>Homework:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Homework is not set at KS3 	<p>Feedback:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Verbal feedback will be given within lessons when students share their practical work. ● All practical feedback will be recorded on Showbie for students to reflect on and use in rehearsals to refine their work. ● Dialogue marking will take place when students are exploring the written component of the course. Written comments will outline what the pupil has done well and a target of how to improve. ● Students will be given time and opportunities to respond to this feedback after key pieces of work. ● Assessments will take place throughout the year. Pupils will be informed on how to improve on future assessments by written and verbal feedback on Showbie. ● Showbie will be checked weekly. This is to check literacy, numeracy, key terms, effort and presentation of work. <p>Homework:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Homework will be set weekly and should take the pupils 30 minutes. ● Homework will be a mixture of written tasks and practical preparation. ● Feedback will be given in writing or as a voice recording on Showbie for all homework tasks ● Pupils will receive feedback from their homework within 2 weeks of the deadline date.
