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Feedback:

- Students will be given time and opportunities to respond to this feedback after key pieces of work.
- Assessments will take place throughout the year. Pupils will be informed on how to improve on future assessments by written and verbal feedback on Showbie.
- Showbie will be checked weekly. This is to check literacy, numeracy, key terms, effort and presentation of work.
