- ✓ Parents buying a service get to see reviews and recommendations of the businesses so can choose a 'supplier' with confidence.
- ✓ Manor will benefit, as every transaction that happens through the Schooliety approach means that an agreed percentage of the bottom line is donated back to the Academy, from the business owner.
- ✓ Ultimately the students win, as this extra income can fund resources and facilities for them!
- ✓ Students and parents will be asked what the funds might be spent on... making this a real community outcome.

How do I get involved?

A review for work carried out can then be posted on Manor's website under a 'Schooliety' section. The donation would support the students by providing funds for them to purchase facilities and resources.

We would like to provide added benefits for each business with networking evenings, the option to appear in a regular newsletter and other future events.
