Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you to those parents that attended the meeting last night about our “iPads for Learning” initiative. If you were not able to make the meeting please do not worry, all the information you need is noted here. In the meeting Mr Barber and Mr Cooper outlined our rationale and vision for the scheme, and I explained the financial aspects of funding an iPad through the school and then took questions from the audience. So our goal is to have every student with their own personal computing device. At Manor this means enabling all to have an Apple iPad. Now that new students to Manor have started and settled into Manor we would like them to join this initiative and be able to support their learning with their own iPad. Therefore I would like to just outline some of the key points and the actions we would now like parents to take.

After a successful introduction of the scheme to all other year groups we would now like to include all new students in the initiative and therefore ask that you provide an iPad for your son/daughter. This can be funded through the school scheme or privately by yourselves. Our price includes an iPad, starter case and headphones, extended warranty and insurance. The process now is that we would like parents to register online and select the appropriate option for an iPad within the next two weeks until **30 November**. Hopefully this will mean delivery and collection in the week beginning the 18 December. We would then like to be using iPads in lessons straight away after the Christmas Break.

So, please access the web portal at <https://edde.education/>, enter the school code, **MAN9614-14** in the school registration box if you wish to join the contribution scheme. Then make your selection, complete the details, and bank pages as required. Finally as a school we have to verify each registration before the order is generated.

The Additional Sibling Reduction is only for where siblings are already on the scheme. This means one child pays the full amount and subsequent children can get the discounted option.

## **Starter items and insurance and care**

The case, headphones and power lead do not always stand up to rigorous usage therefore if these break or fail then they need to be replaced by yourself (in the case of the power lead, unless it breaks in the first few weeks. it is difficult to get it replaced on the warranty). Therefore good care and careful use should be encouraged.

We self-insure the iPads on our scheme. This speeds up repairs and streamlines the claim process. However in the event of malicious damage, multiple claims and/or lack of due care and attention especially where the case has been removed then we reserve the right to return the iPad to school stock, payments to date may or may not be returned, less the cost of repairs dependent on the circumstances. The iPad however is covered for accidental damage whilst in the case both at school and home. Theft is also covered where reasonable precautions have been taken and a police report reference number has been obtained. Lost iPads are not covered.

## **Bringing your own iPad or you do not wish to join the initiative**

If you already have an iPad that you wish your child to use then it is very important that the device is insured for use in and out of school though this would be your choice. We cannot take any responsibility for your device. If you intend to provide your own iPad and insure it yourself please could you email the address below and let us know your intentions. Equally if you do not intend to join the scheme then please let us know.

Some parents, for a range of reasons prefer not to join the initiative. In this case an iPad will be provided during school hours but will not be allowed to be taken home. Equally, if an iPad has been returned to stock, then that student will also have an iPad to use during school hours. Again if you intend to not join the initiative then please let us know on the email address below. However for the initiative to commence we do need a minimum of 80% of students having their own iPad, either through our scheme, or provided by themselves.

Finally in cases of genuine financial hardship we would like you to get in contact and have a conversation with us.
