Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform you of the opportunities for overseas trips for KS4 students next year (18-19) in order that you can discuss which – if any – you would like your son/daughter to attend. We are very lucky to have staff who are keen to take trips abroad and we are proud of the many opportunities that we can offer students – however I recognise that this comes at a considerable cost to you, so in order to help with your planning these are the trips that currently are scheduled:

**The Italy Trip for Y10 Geography Students** – This will take place in **March 2019** and will cost **£750**.

**The Battlefields Trip for Y9 & 10 History Students** – this will take place in **April 2019** and will cost **£340**.

(These trips have already been advertised to parents)

**The Romania Trip for Y10 Leadership Students** – This will take place in the summer term 2019 and will cost **approximately £800** with possible costs for Hep A/Hep B injections.

**The Taize trip** with the Archbishop of York for Y10 students - This will be in July and will cost approximately **£70**.

The individual departments will issue letters about the trips with a schedule for payments.

There will also be many opportunities to go on other residential trips in the UK led by Art, CCF, PE, PA, ASDAN and D of E.

In **2019-20** (so far!) there will be a ski trip for Y10&11 PE students, a music trip to New York, the Malawi trip (Y11), Leadership to Romania, the Italy trip for Geography and Taize.
