- 3. Volunteering (e.g. Charity Shop, Church Action, Organise a Charity Event)
- 4. Expedition Two walking expeditions (practice and assessed) to develop map reading skills and camp craft.

The cost for the Award is £125; this payment includes the DofE admin fee, accommodation, training, access to the school equipment and the assessment costs. The payment schedule will be a £75 payment at the start of February and a final £50 payment by the end of April.
