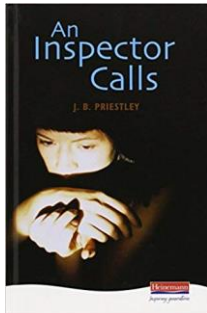
Return of school copies of English texts

The texts you may have borrowed from us are:

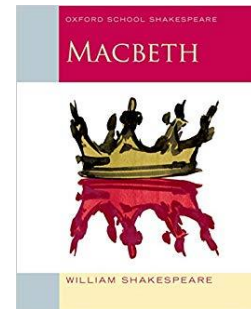
An Inspector Calls
