I am delighted to say that we will be offering a History site study visit to Caernarfon Castle [on Wednesday 18th September](#). As part of our AQA GCSE course we study Medieval England: the reign of Edward I, 1272-1307. This unit includes Edward's use of castles in his conquest of Wales. Caernarfon is perhaps the finest and most interesting castle built on Edward's orders, revealing much about the nature of his reign. We will depart Manor at 7.15am and aim to return at [around 7pm](#) [this could change]. The expected cost of the visit is around £23. The visit will be on a school day, so your child will have the responsibility to catch up any work that he or she misses.

Whilst at Caernarfon Castle, we will explore the site and take a self-guided tour. This visit is not compulsory, but we are sure it will be a very interesting and beneficial day. We will also be providing entertainment on the long coach journeys.
