



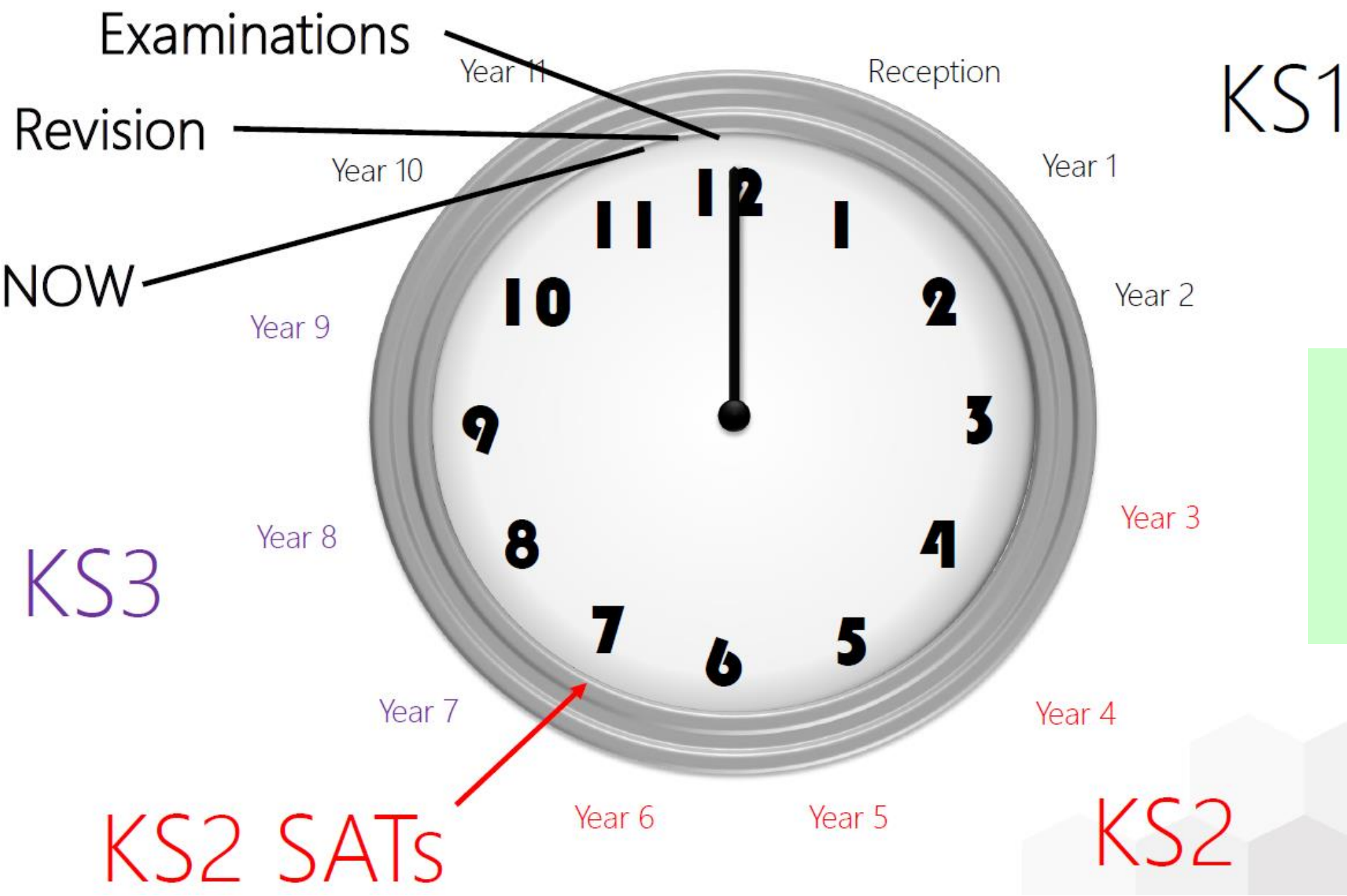

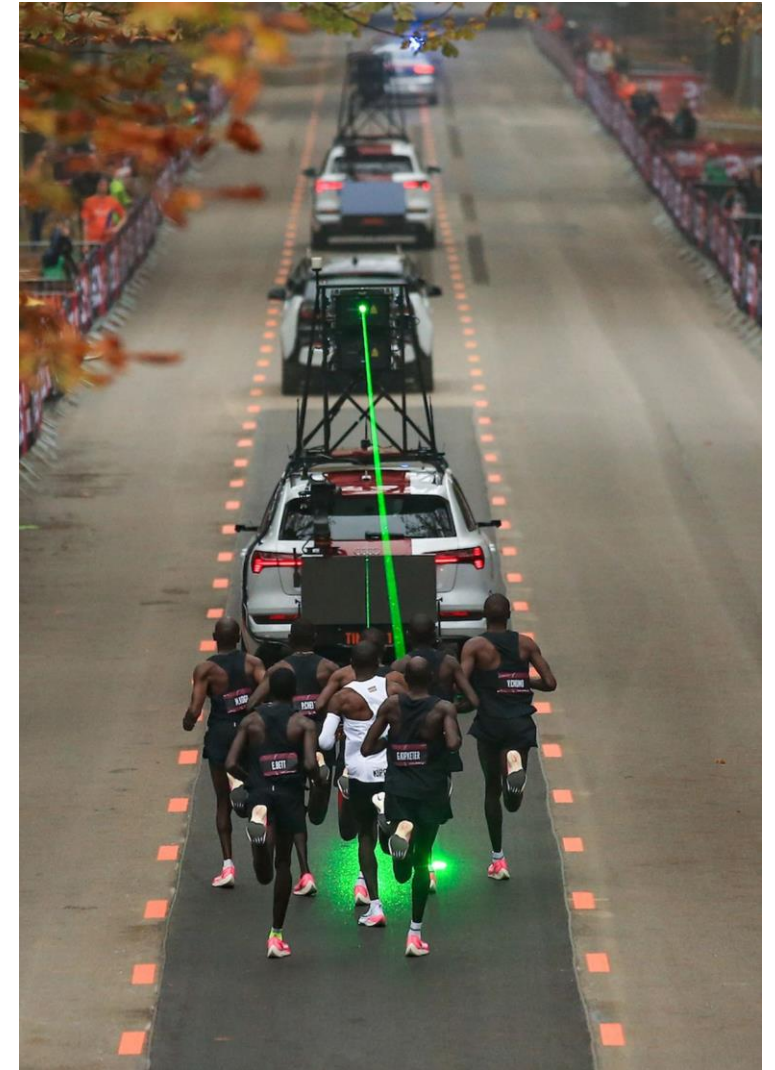

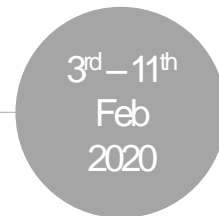

Last Steps before the Mocks...

Maximise attendance

- If in doubt over illness – come to school
- Be punctual
- Late arrival misses key lesson starters

Make use of revision sessions, resources and staff expertise

- Revise at home – in school work will **not** be enough
- Make use of **practice** resources
- Make a reasonable programme and stick to it
- Be ACTIVE in revision
- Revising is not ‘time off’ but a crucial part of your exam preparation
- Take responsibility for own success

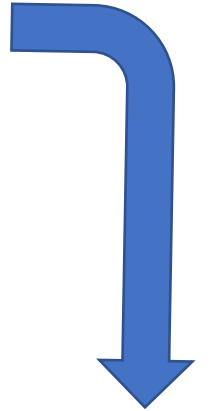
Mock Exams Procedures

Timetables and Seating Plans

- This week, you will receive your personal exam timetable
- It includes exam locations and seating plans
- You must go to and sit in these seats – these aren't our rules, these are JCQ exam rules imposed on us. Any alterations, they need to know about in advance (hence why I sent out a letter to your parents a few weeks ago)

Morning Mocks

- Breakfast club is from 8am
- Exam titles and seating plans displayed on screens around school
- 8:30 drop bags & electronic equipment off in lockers and go to **assembly point** (outside PE changing rooms, back down corridor towards DT)



Morning Mocks

- 8:40am – released to area in front of hall. Line up in front of row you will be sitting in (this is on your timetable and screens – it will be different for each exam)
- 8:40am – students in rooms P2 and P6 released to go straight to these rooms and line up outside. You await the **lead invigilator**, who will call you in. You will get started as soon as possible
- Students in the hall, you will be called in through the front entrance.
- Reminder: no electronic equipment is allowed on your person. If you're wearing a watch, it needs to be taken off and placed on your desk. Smart watches / activity trackers must be in bags and not in the exam room.

Morning Mocks

- 8:45am – Once inside the exam room, you're under JCQ rules. Again, these aren't Manor's rules – they are nationwide rules - we just have to follow them:
 - Enter in silence: Rows are clearly labelled on the wall, seat numbers go from 1-11, seat 1 is towards the far wall
 - If there is an issue, raise your hand and an invigilator will come to you
 - **PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE** – don't communicate in any way – we have to report any breaches to exam boards. Exam boards can exclude you from sitting any further exams with them, in serious cases. Again, these aren't our rules, but we have to follow them for the benefit of all

Morning Mocks

- All morning exams should finish by 11am, ready for break
- For longer morning exams, students with extra time will still get their break, it may occur slightly later than other students, but will be slightly extended than others
- Period 3 – revision lessons – please bring revision material
- Reminder: if you don't have a mock exam, you go to your normal lesson with revision material to make the most of the suspended timetable.

Afternoon Mocks

- Full lunch occurs at 12:20
- Exam titles and seating plans displayed on screens around school, especially around the Balcony
- 1:10 – 1:15 go to **assembly point** (outside PE changing rooms, back down corridor towards DT) - please go via the English or Science stairs down.
- Due to the sheer numbers of students, a one way system to the assembly point has to be in operation – come to it from DT corridor

Afternoon Mocks

- 1:20 – students are released a row at a time to the edge of the hall.
- At the assembly point, please try and stand according to seating rows – ie if you know you're in row A, stand closest to the front. Row H in the middle – row P furthest towards the back, right by the DT corridor.
- As per the morning exam, when you're called in, enter via the front entrance
- For afternoon exams, if it finishes after 2:45pm, you may go straight home. A letter confirming this will be sent to your parents by Mr Hill
- If you don't have an afternoon exam, you remain in revision lessons as normal, until 3:20pm

Wednesday 23rd October – Careers Morning

X Band
