- York Apprenticeships

Home schools are responsible for informing all Year 11 pupils of the arrangements and supporting them with queries, e.g. concerning transport.

A list of attendees will be taken at ALL information taster/sessions and sent to the home school on the day the sessions take place.

Summary of what is on offer on Tuesday 11 and Thursday 13 January 2022

All Saints School

All Saints will run the A level taster day on Tuesday, 11 January 2022. This is a full day of lesson tasters and Y11 students from All Saints and visiting students from other schools will be able to choose four A Level or BTEC options. Visiting students are asked to assemble in the hall at 8.40 am. The taster day will mirror life in the Sixth Form, so it is a non-uniform day. Further details about the programme for the Taster Day can be found at the end of this guide.

Archbishop Holgate's School

Archbishops will run two full-day taster events on both 11 and 13 January 2022. Each day will consist of a welcome from the Director of Sixth Form, followed by a tour of the school and the opportunity to try a number of subjects. After lunch with staff and students, Year 11 visitors will take part in a Sixth Form tutor session. The day will finish with an individual discussion of potential course options and future career pathways. An additional information sheet for AHS is included (see page 12 of this guide); please print copies as required.

Fulford School

Fulford will run taster sessions on both 11 and 13 January 2022. Each session will consist of a welcome from the Director of Sixth Form, a tour of the school, an informal discussion with current students, the opportunity to sample a Sixth Form lesson and a discussion about potential course options and future progression routes.

Huntington School

Huntington School will be running taster sessions on both 11 and 13 January 2022. On Tuesday, 11 January, Huntington will run two half-day taster sessions: one in the morning (9 am - 11 am) and one in the afternoon (1.15 - 3.15 pm). These sessions will include a discussion of course choices, a school tour, a chance to meet current students, and the opportunity to attend a Sixth Form lesson.

On Thursday, 13 January, they will hold a full Taster Day (8.35 am – 3.30 pm). Students will experience what it's like to be at Huntington Sixth Form and can sample up to five subjects on the day. This session is non-uniform.



Year 11 Apprenticeship Taster Day Application

Thursday 13 January 2022



The York Apprenticeship Hub at the City of York Council, along with local employers and training providers, can help you find out what it's like to be an apprentice in York.

What's on offer?

There are various local employers offering a taster. You will get a half-day or full-day session on what it would be like to have an apprenticeship job in your chosen sector.

When will I find out if I have a place?

Tasters are allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. By Friday, 10 December, you will be notified if you have been allocated a taster (giving you enough time to apply for a sixth form taster if both your options are full). You will then receive further details closer to the day.

What happens on the day?

You will receive an introduction to the organisation and apprenticeships, followed by an experience of working and training with that employer. You will get the opportunity to learn about the organisation and different job roles in that sector.

What do I wear?

Please dress appropriately for the type of work e.g.

- construction, wear clothing you don't mind getting dirty and sturdy shoes
- business / professional, wear smart clothing, e.g. trousers and a shirt or dress
- child care / health care, wear black clothing if possible and comfortable shoes

Do I need to bring anything?

Please ensure you have a face covering, hand sanitiser, water, a pen and paper and a packed-lunch (if it's a full-day taster). Please note: lunch will not be provided unless otherwise stated.

Transport

You will need to get yourself to your taster location by 8.50 am for a 9 am start, unless otherwise stated. You will then need to get yourself back home or to school, depending on the finish time.

Covid-19

The Apprenticeship Taster Day will take place in accordance with local and national government guidance at that time. If the employer you are visiting requires you to take additional Covid-19 safety measures, we will let you know in advance. If local or national guidance affects the way in which the taster can be delivered, we will work with you, your school and the employer on an alternative arrangement.
