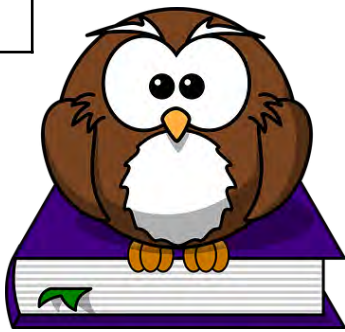

<b>Tip 1</b>	Learn and revise vocabulary regularly, approximately 20 words a week
<b>Tip 2</b>	Learn how to ask, "How do you say X?" in the language and use it often
<b>Tip 3</b>	Download relevant apps to revise: DuLingo, WordReference, etc.
<b>Tip 4</b>	Set achievable and specific learning goals with a time limit
<b>Tip 5</b>	Allow yourself to make mistakes, even silly ones. They help you learn!

<b>Tip 1</b>	Learn and revise vocabulary regularly, approximately 10 words a week
<b>Tip 2</b>	Carry a pocket dictionary and look up words you aren't sure of
<b>Tip 3</b>	Little and often revision: aim to do 5-10 minutes of practice a day
<b>Tip 4</b>	Create flashcards of vocabulary per unit that you study, on cards or online
<b>Tip 5</b>	Understand why you are learning the language and be inspired by it!
